After studying theatre at the Victorian College of the Arts he helped create the *Flying Fruit Fly International Children’s Circus*, taking up the position of Artistic Director from the outset. In 1984, on behalf of the company, he won the *BHP Pursuit of Excellence Award* in Arts and Literature.
